History:

Vessel was used as a racer out of Jamaica Bay area and was lovingly maintained. It was donated in September 2006 after owner had heart surgery. It was stored in the water, though not used, in a wake-free Long Island marina until fall 2007. It was then hauled and stored on the hard Fall 2007 and relaunched September 2008 and brought to Red Hook for sale. Sails are in excellent condition. Most were new when the owner had to let go of the boat and were stored off the boat. The cabin was not used and needs work if you plan to use boat as a cruiser. Main halyard needs replacement. **Sails are available separately.**
